- Collect data from Healthy Chef events to assess the effectiveness of programs and outcomes, if applicable
- Identify food insecure, or other vulnerable community members, that may be best served by the Healthy Chef program

Successful candidates must possess:

- Associates Degree in Culinary Arts or equivalent experience for a minimum of two years
- Strong food safety background (FSMA training, ServSafe Manager or equivalent)
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to find creative solutions with minimum supervision
- Strong organizational skills, flexibility, multi-tasking, and follow-through capacity
- Occasional evenings and weekend availability
